Thank you Kinetic for your support and partnership, we look forward to continuing to work together to reduce the road toll.

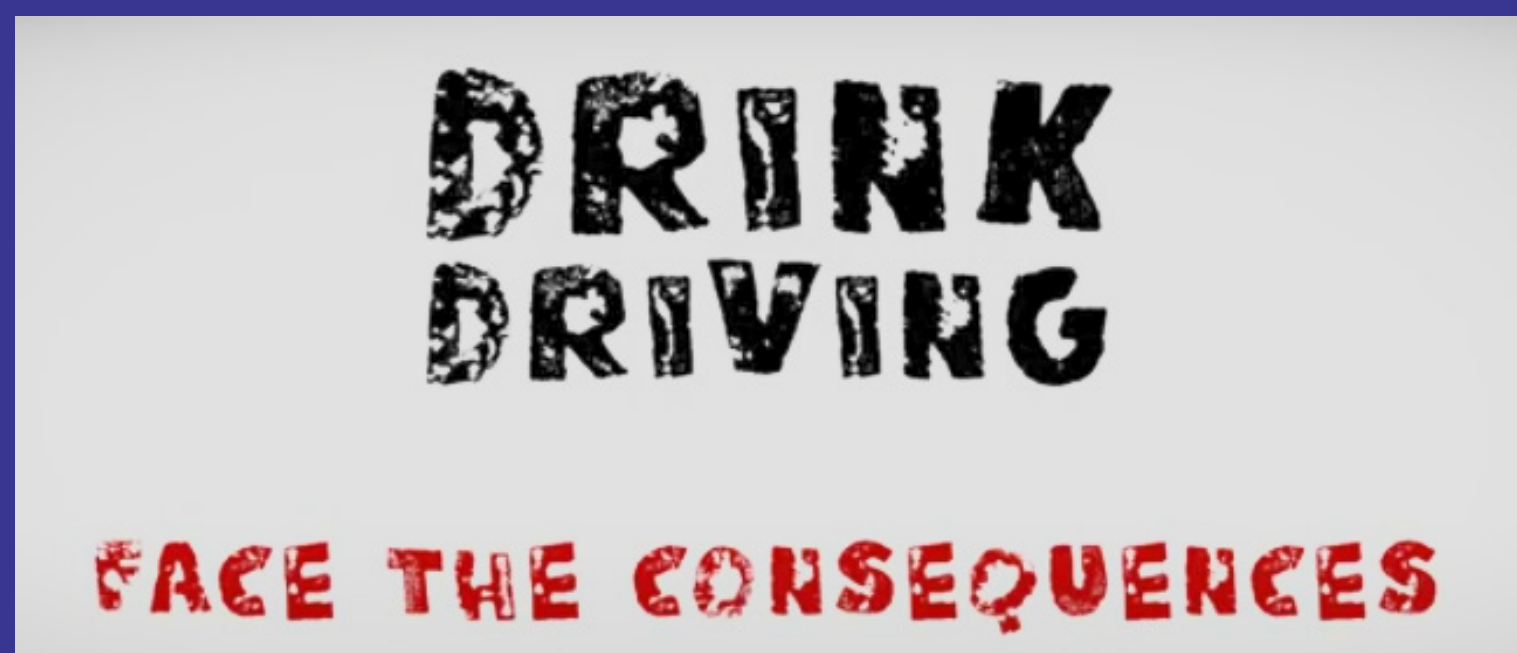


# UPCOMING PROJECTS & CAMPAIGNS

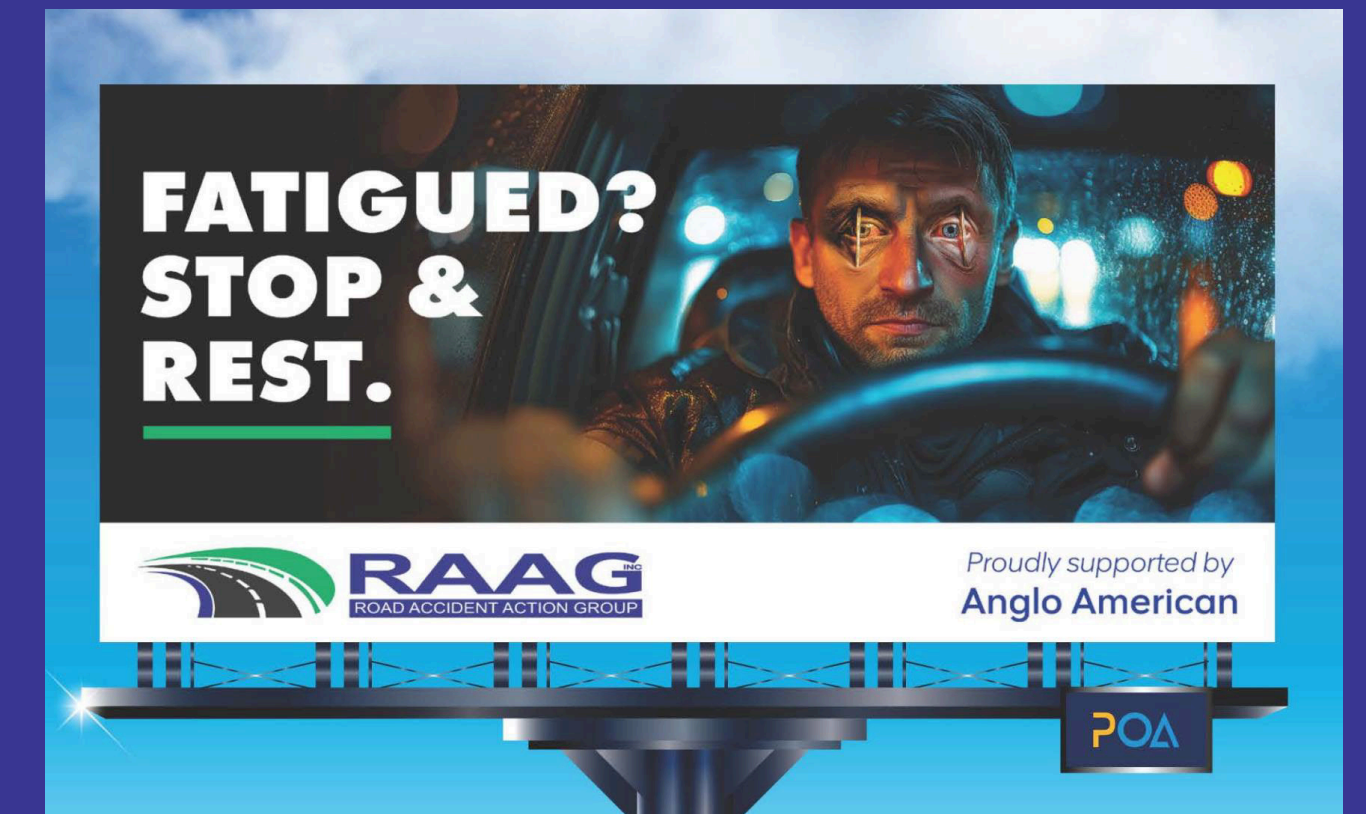
